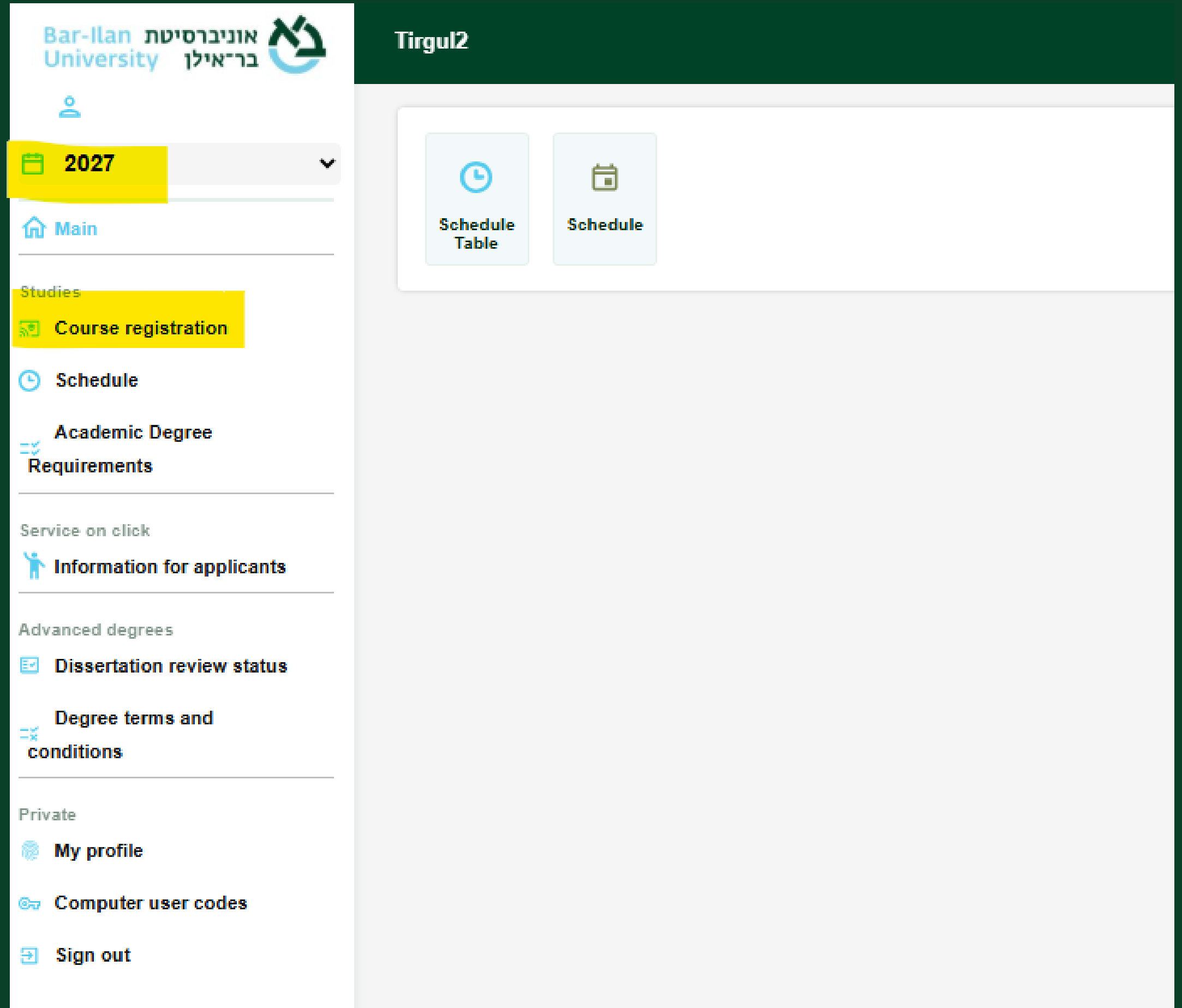
Intro

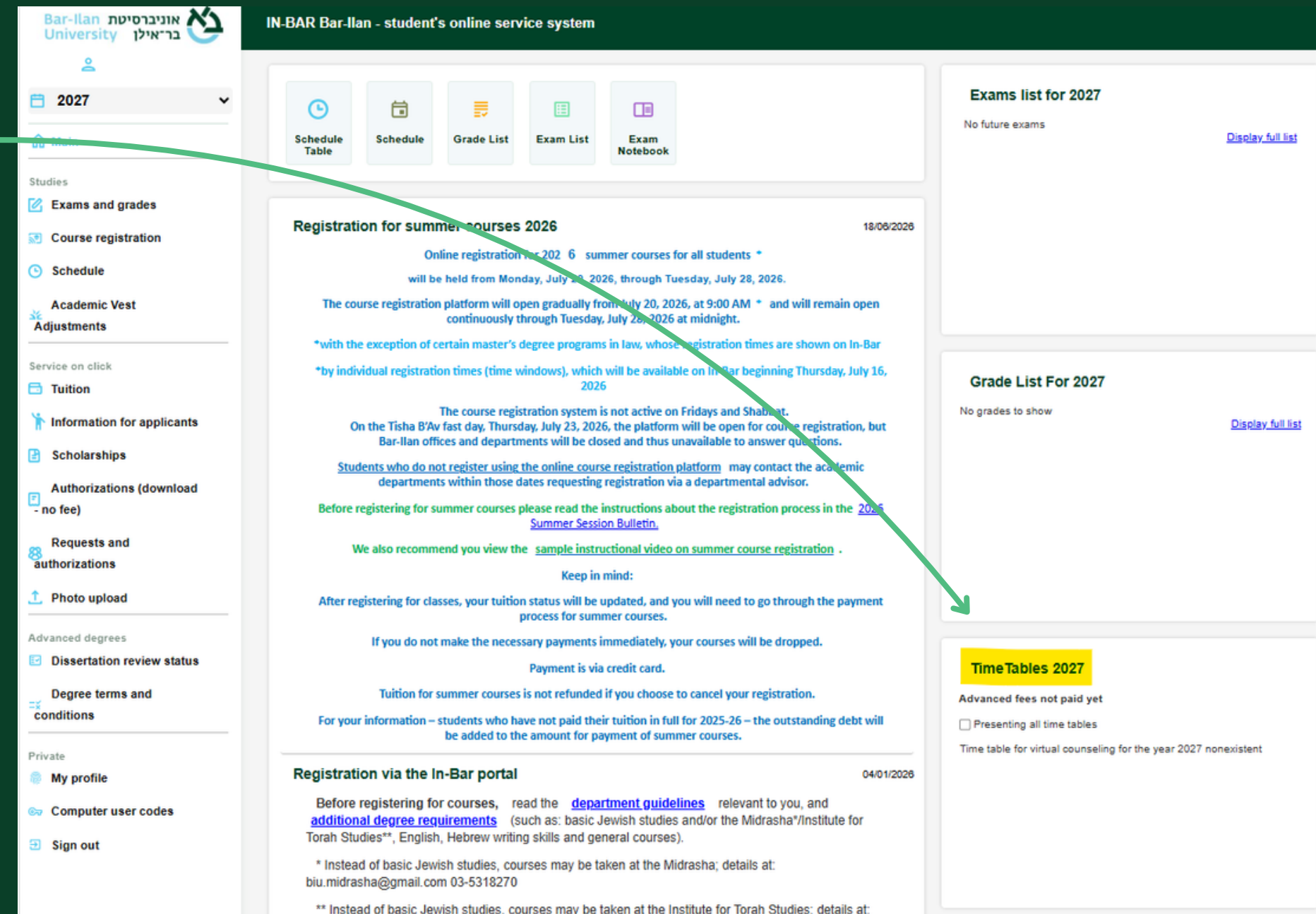

Registration for summer courses 2026 18/08/2026

Online registration for 2026 summer courses for all students *

will be held from Monday, July 20, 2026, through Tuesday, July 28, 2026.

The course registration platform will open gradually from July 20, 2026, at 9:00 AM * and will remain open continuously through Tuesday, July 28, 2026 at midnight.

*with the exception of certain master's degree programs in law, whose registration times are shown on In-Bar

*by individual registration times (time windows), which will be available on In-Bar beginning Thursday, July 16, 2026

The course registration system is not active on Fridays and Shabbat. On the Tisha B'Av fast day, Thursday, July 23, 2026, the platform will be open for course registration, but Bar-Ilan offices and departments will be closed and thus unavailable to answer questions.

Students who do not register using the online course registration platform may contact the academic departments within those dates requesting registration via a departmental advisor.

Before registering for summer courses please read the instructions about the registration process in the 2026 Summer Session Bulletin.

We also recommend you view the sample instructional video on summer course registration .

Keep in mind:

After registering for classes, your tuition status will be updated, and you will need to go through the payment process for summer courses.

If you do not make the necessary payments immediately, your courses will be dropped.

Payment is via credit card.

Tuition for summer courses is not refunded if you choose to cancel your registration.

For your information – students who have not paid their tuition in full for 2025-26 – the outstanding debt will be added to the amount for payment of summer courses.
